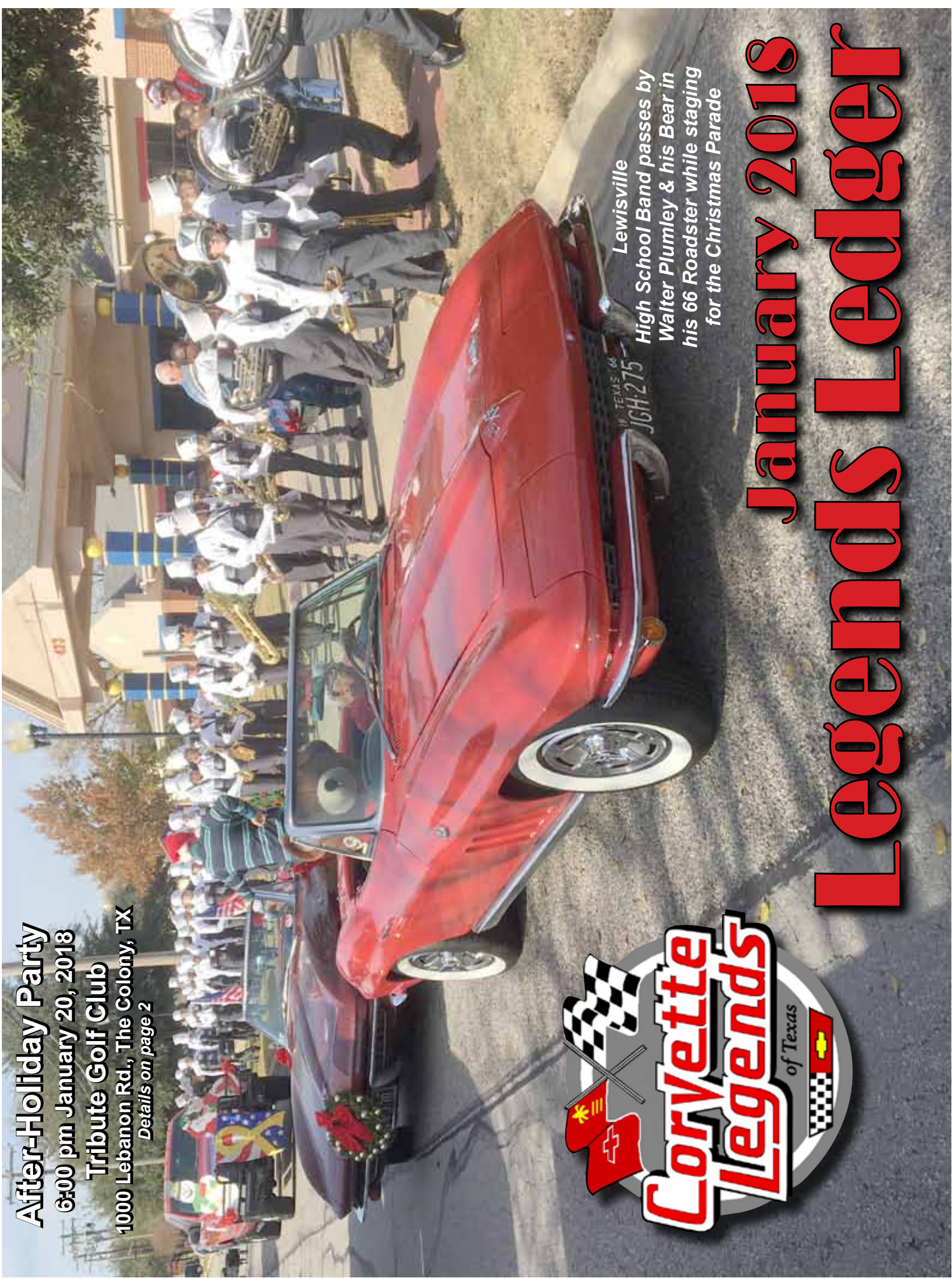

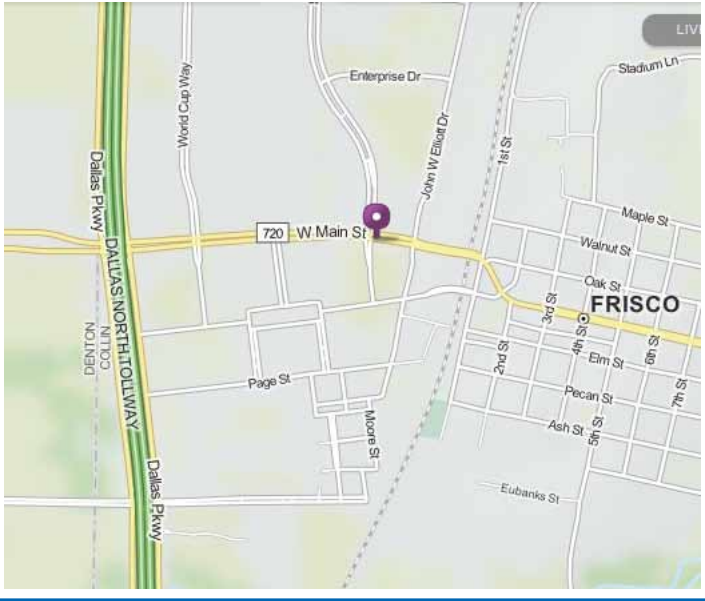

They used the Legends' body jacks and transferred the body to a cart. Then used John Yobi's trailer to take the body to Preston's house (also in Flower Mound) for more body work. Bob Rockett returned the next Monday to help Tom get the engine onto an engine stand.
