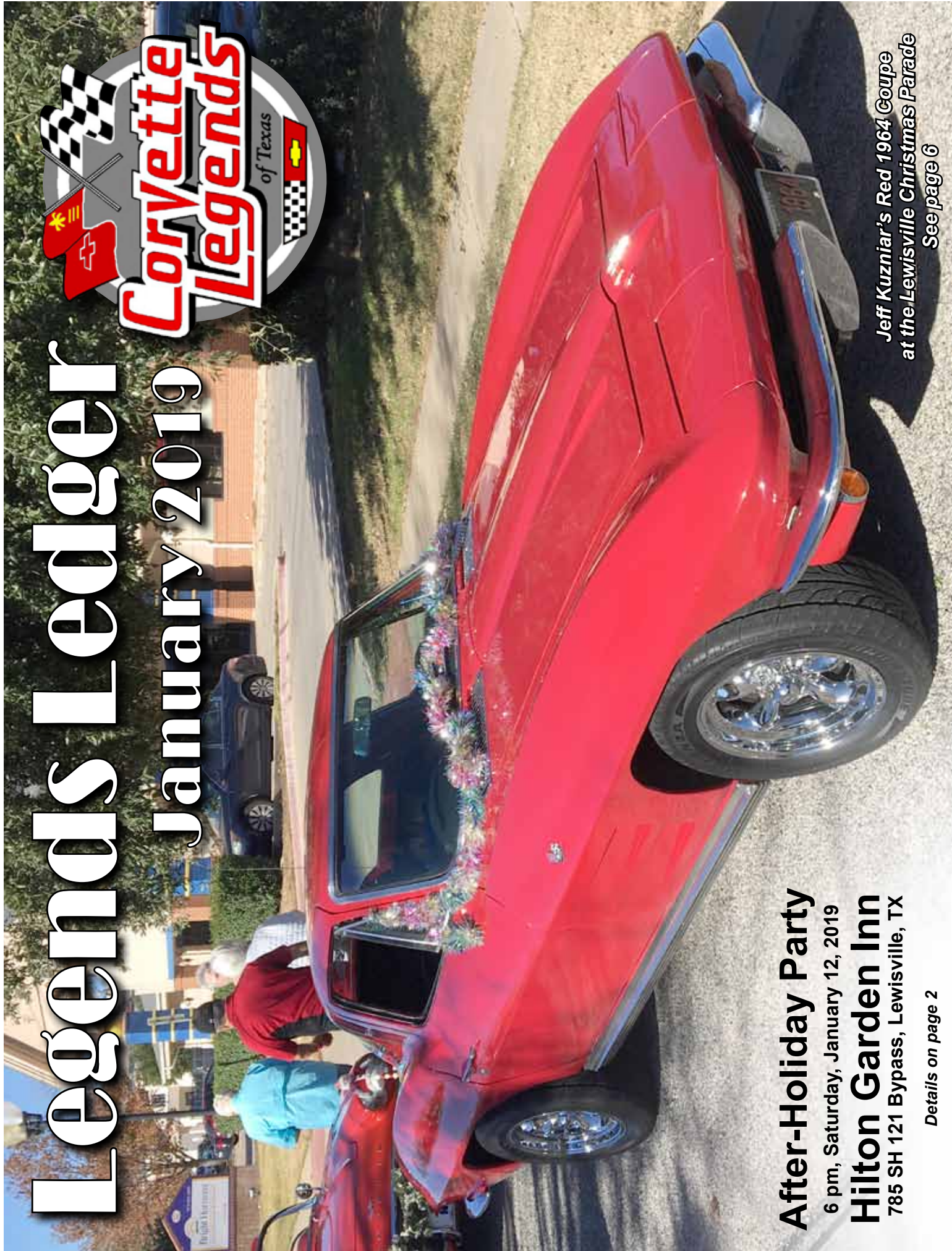

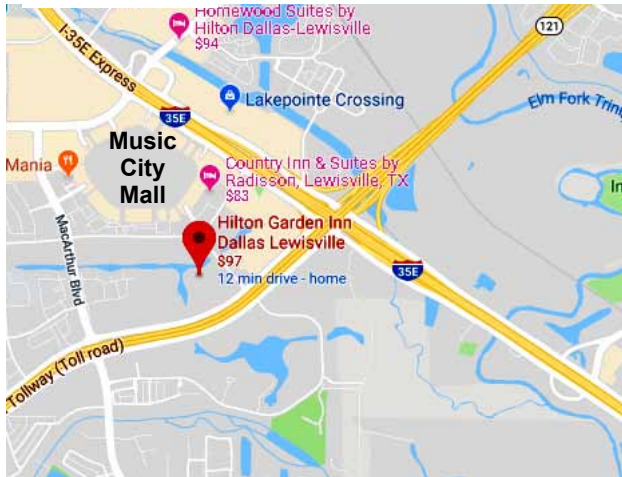

The Members of Corvette Legends were called to order by Sam Deneault, President, at 12:15 pm. The minutes were approved.

Tom Lainson reported that the club membership remains at 131 members – see him if you don't have a club badge. Larry Dyer reinforced Tom's membership report, noting that club members can help the club grow and get better by actively promoting the club and its activities to friends and other car enthusiasts.

Diane Preston is looking for Corvette stories to publish in the Newsletter. Susan Joseph notified members that the club picked up the tab for unpaid meals (\$81) at last month's general meeting. There may have been some confusion because of inexperienced waitresses, but members please make sure you receive your bill and pay for your meal before leaving the restaurant.

The After Holiday Party will be held at the Hilton Garden Inn in Lewisville on January 12, 2019. Tom Atchison indicated that the member's price will be the same as last year (\$35); ALL RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT MUST BE MADE NOT LATER THAN DECEMBER 31, 2018. Meet Our Members

Dee & Roger Elliott

Engaged in High School, they married after graduation in 1960 and just celebrated 58 years. They worked at TI in their early years and bought their first house in Plano in 1961, where they kept their first Corvette, a 1961 Jewel Blue. After children and careers at TI, they moved away to Tulsa for a year, then back to Texas to establish a long line of Business Equipment-related companies.

After a successful business life, Roger began searching for that Jewel Blue 61, but gave up due to the limited number produced and availability at the time. A chance encounter with Tom Lainson and his Red 61 at a country car show in 2010 renewed Roger's passion for Corvettes and soon he was on the search once again for that Jewel Blue 1961.

While in Arizona, Roger found a rare Roman Red 1961 with only 6,000 miles, and it was all original. The car had been a one owner in a collection in Phoenix and was just too perfect to pass on buying it. In December of 2011, the 61 came to Texas just in time for Miss Dee's 70th birthday.

After a thorough inspection, it was discovered that the 283 V8, interior, tires and paint were all original. After a wet sanding and a complete lubrication, the

car looked great. It has now had some upgrades for driving and has a permanent home in the Elliott Collection. It has won over 50 trophies and four "Best of Show" awards.

Needless to say, the Elliott's love Corvettes and their many Corvette friends. They are active in their local Sulphur Springs Corvette Club and remain members of Corvette Legends of Texas. Roger & Dee are grateful to all the Legends members who have supported their activities and have shared their friendship. All this because of a great guy and good friend, Tom Lainson.

We have Dee & Roger to thank for the great weekend we spend every fall in Sulphur Springs. Several times the great Friday night party was held at their hangar, pictured above. They are a driving force in the Sulphur Springs Corvette Club and Legends' link to that event.

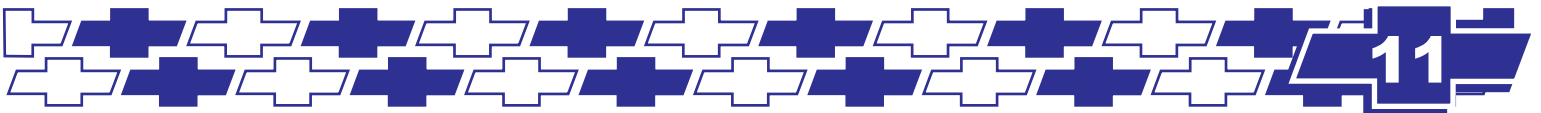
