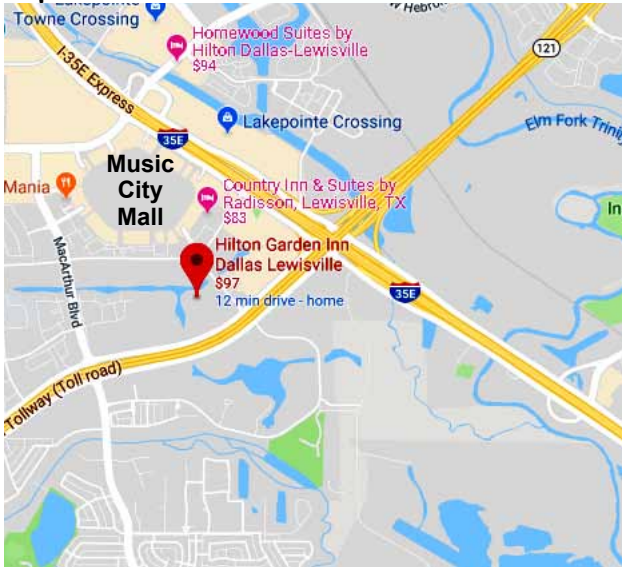

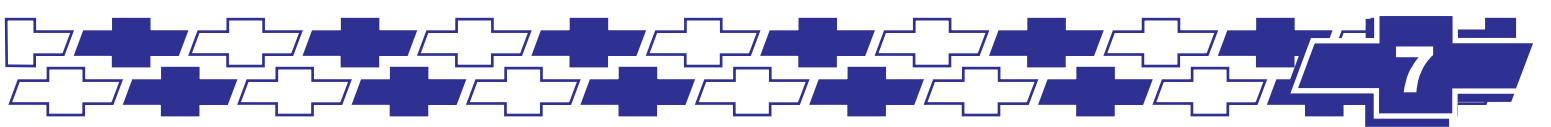

The Ultimate Car Cover

I have had one or more Corvettes for over 35 years. I have used just about every cover offered, from simple drapes to fully enclosed covers. I have used inexpensive and expensive covers. But the cover combination I last employed I find to be by far the best I have used.

This is strictly an indoor cover, but it works very well. I purchased a Satin Cover from California Covers thru Corvette Central. This cover is fitted--but not tight and you will not experience any abrasion of your car's paint. It drapes the car to the floor, has a fleece underbelly and is extremely soft.

The only problem I noted was, like anything else in a working garage, it collected dust. The dust did not penetrate the cover to the car's surface but I was concerned about the covers' long-term performance, if I allowed the dust to build up on/in the cover. The outer layer, being satin, was easily cleaned, but I didn't like being shackled with the maintenance.

So I purchased a CHEAP outer cover--a very light-weight plastic outer cover. These covers are advertised as throw-away covers, and are less than \$6.00. Body shops use them often to cover cars in their shops to keep dust and paint overspray off cars stored awaiting their turn. They are not fitted - they come by length



(12ft, 16ft, 20ft) but they have an elastic band around their edge so they stay in place. You can find them on Ebay under disposable plastic car covers. This layer protects the Satin cover and car beneath it.

Collectively this combination of covers provides excellent protection. I recommend it highly.

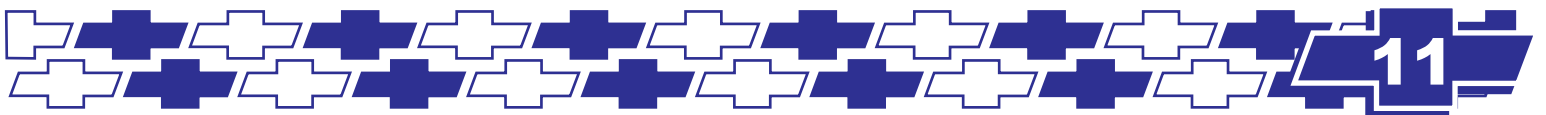
