Tom Douglas



Tom Douglas was one of the founding members of the Corvette Legends of Texas in 1997. He and several other owners of early model Corvettes sought to form a club that would focus more on the older cars, while enjoying and appreciating later model Vettes.

He served as Treasurer of Legends from its founding until

2009. He was one of the most active and knowledgeable members participating in the Wrenches, where members work on each other's Corvettes. There are endless stories of things that happened during Wrenches on Tuesday and Thursday nights at Don Clark's shop and in members' garages.

The raffle at Legends meetings was Tom's baby. He supplied a wide and interesting variety of raffle prizes every month at meetings. He was in sales for Fiberweb, and was on the road a lot before retiring. He would often spend his evenings out of town gathering the door prizes for the next meeting. Sometimes your door prize would be in his McDonald's lunch sack, which he might throw to you at the meeting. That was OK if it was a roll of towels, but those big gallon jars of pickles became a problem and he had to be reined in.

Tom was a well-respected Master Judge for National Corvette Restorers Society (NCRS) and received a special recognition from them in 2017 for his many years of service. You could expect to run into Tom at just about any NCRS event, from regionals in Kissimmee, Florida to national conventions in Novi, Michigan and beyond.

In recent years he was most frequently seen in his 1980 Blue Coupe (see cover), or his 1991 Red Convertible. He also had a 1970 Coupe and 1959 Red Roadster. ...and lots and lots and lots of Corvette parts.

Tom was active in the Cornhusker Corvette Club back in the 70's before moving to Plano, TX and the Lone Star Corvette Club before founding Legends.

Tom was born in May 1947 and passed away January 13, 2018 after a long battle with kidney disease. On June 24, 1970, he married Margaret in Houston, Texas, who passed away November 4, 2006. He is survived by his daughter, Lori Douglas, son in law, Mark Nichols, grandson, Brenden Nichols, his dog Heidi (his dogs are family too), sister Jan Lewis and in-laws Cal and Mari-

anne Hetrick. He was an eight-year veteran of the US Air Force, where he served in the Vietnam war.

Per his wishes there will not be a funeral service, "I want people to remember me the way I was; not laying in a box. No Suit! Just a Corvette shirt and shorts, my club uniform!!!" He was laid to rest in the Field of Honor at Ridgeview Memorial Park in Allen, Texas, next to Margaret in a private family ceremony. In lieu of flowers donations can be made in his name to the National Kidney Foundation, Operation Kindness (no kill animal shelter) or the SPCA.

His daughter, Lori, is working with Corvette Legends of Texas and Texas NCRS to organize a tribute dinner cruise and Tom's final raffle (what could be more appropriate). All raffle proceeds will be divided equally among the aforementioned organizations. We will update you in the next couple of weeks with a time and location. Lori says, "I know it would please my father to see all of his friends show up in their Corvettes for a final farewell."

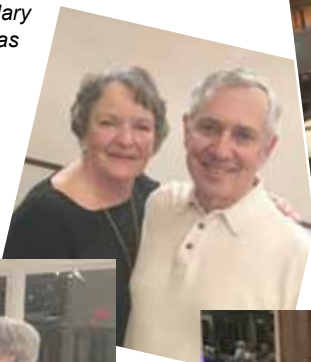

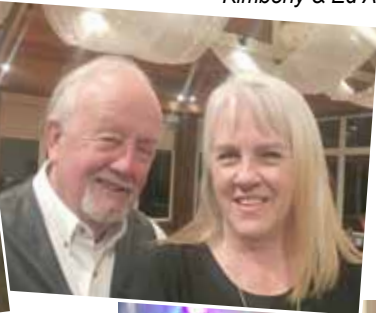

2017 Member of the Year

Tom Atchison

Tom Atchison was named 2017 Member of the Year at the After-Holiday Party held January 20, 2018. Tom has truly been the "Member of the History of the Corvette Legends of Texas". He was a founding member of the club and served as President for 12 years and secretary for one year. He wasn't eligible for the Member of the Year Award while serving as an elected officer.

He is responsible for recruiting Huffines Chevrolet to be our sponsor during his presidency and still maintains our club relationship through personal contacts.

What is outstanding about Tom, verses other past presidents, is that he has remained active ever since he turned the gavel over to Sam Deneault. He has been in charge of the After-Holiday Party every year, arranging the monthly Sunday Brunches, and entering Legends in the Christmas Parade. He even attends all board meetings, as well as monthly meetings and most events, in town and out-of town. He has been our ambassador to the National Corvette Museum and has even had his one-owner 1963 Red Z06 Coupe on display there for 13 months. Upon delivery of his 2001 Red Z06 Coupe they were on display together at the museum. He has since sold both and drives a Blue 2004 Coupe.

Past Members of the Year

A special presentation is made each year to the Corvette Legends of Texas Member of the Year. The award was conceived by Larry Dyer to recognize a member or member couple who fully participate in club events and drive, display and enjoy their Corvette. Currently elected officers are not eligible. Our club survives on many members, who put a lot of effort into planning events, keeping things running, and reaching out to our members and other Corvette owners. This Award acknowledges just one of many who are deserving each year.



2008-Gerry and Linda Boren

received the first Member of the Award for 2008, because they were always at events near and far with their one-owner 1960 Corvette... usually with the top down. In accepting the Award the Borens invited us to accompany them on a

two-week trip to Boise, Idaho that summer to attend a Corvette event and tour some other areas of the Pacific Northwest in their Corvette. Since then, they have shared their travels all over the country in the Vette. Eventually, they moved back to Idaho, but drove back thru Texas in 2014 on their six-week cruise all over the country.



2009-Bill Tichy has been active in all aspects of the club, but is most notable for having organized many trips for our group. He headed up a 17-day trip in 2009, which included being group captain with the '09 Corvette Caravan to Bowling Green, then took us on an

extended trip north around Lake Michigan. He took us on weekend trips to Fredericksburg, Texas and around the hill country, on a tour of the Painted Churches of Texas, to historic Jefferson, Texas and trips to Colorado and New England since then!



2010-Jerry Echols demonstrates the authentic spirit of the Corvette Sport. He is always there to lend a hand, or offer advice. He is a frequent participant in weekend wrenches to help other members with repairs and projects on their Corvettes. He drives his car

most recently leading a Texas tour with the C2 registry group. He shows his enthusiasm for the full enjoyment of his old 1966. In 2011 he accepted the club position of VP of Special Events, and has done an exceptional job organizing club displays at Autorama, the New Car Show and State Fair of Texas.



2011-Jan Dyer created a major fund-raising project in 2011 by collecting recipes from Legends club members, organizing them into a cookbook, editing it, getting it published and managing its sales. Despite uncooperative weather at the State Fair and the Christmas

parade, where Jan planned for us to sell them, we sold out and presented \$1,500 to Patriot Paws. Jan has been an active participant, gracious hostess and friendly face in all club events, since she and husband, Larry, moved to Texas in 2002.



2012-Diane Preston has created the monthly club newsletter since 2007. She is at most club events, because she has to write an article about it and take pictures. Diane believes that the newsletter is vital to keeping members involved in the club. She also came up with

the idea and design of the club directory, as another way to embrace new members and build a stronger organization. She and Bill moved to Texas in 2004, immediately sought out the club and appreciate being warmly welcomed by the members.



2013-Chuck Endicott. Our club Weekend Wrenches activity has depended heavily on Chuck's vast experience working on Corvettes. He was Weekend Wrench Coordinator for many years and this program wouldn't have gotten started without him. He not only

knows the old Corvettes mechanically, but is skilled at paint and body work and freely shares his expertise. Many of the club wrench sessions were held at his shop in Krum. He now lives in Waxahachie, so anytime he comes to help a member, he's making quite a drive just to get there.



2014-Susan Joseph has served as Lady Legends Chairman and introduced a unique new iron-on logo for the ladies' shirts. She was a key organizer of the annual Patriot Paws Silent Charity Auction for many years. In 2013 she devised a system to run the auction as a Live

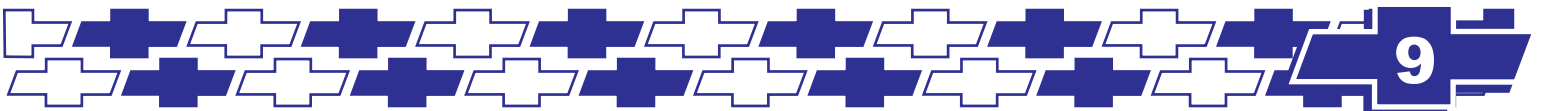

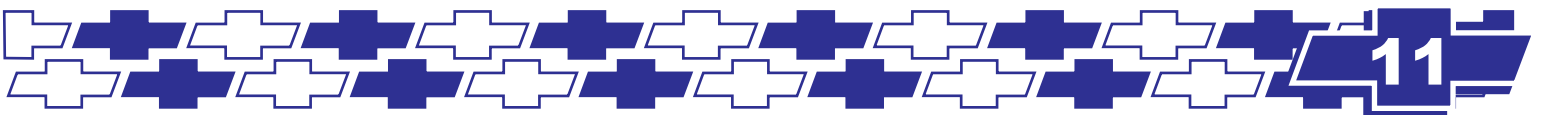
