

Normally, for a non-Good-Guys Member to register their vehicle for the show, the cost would be \$85 for three-day access to the event for one car and two people. They've offered a three-day vehicle registration plus a Goodguys Gold Annual Membership (\$45 value) for a total cost of \$80 per participant.

We would like to meet or exceed the 20 car minimum so we can get a dedicated reserved area set aside for the exclusive use of our members. This would allow us to distribute Cub literature and solicit new members.

If we make the 20 car minimum, I would envision us concentrating on Saturday of the show to gather as a club, bring coolers, shade coverings and have a great time as a group. Hopefully we can grow this into an annual event to replace at least one of the two events that are no longer available (State Fair & New Car Show).


