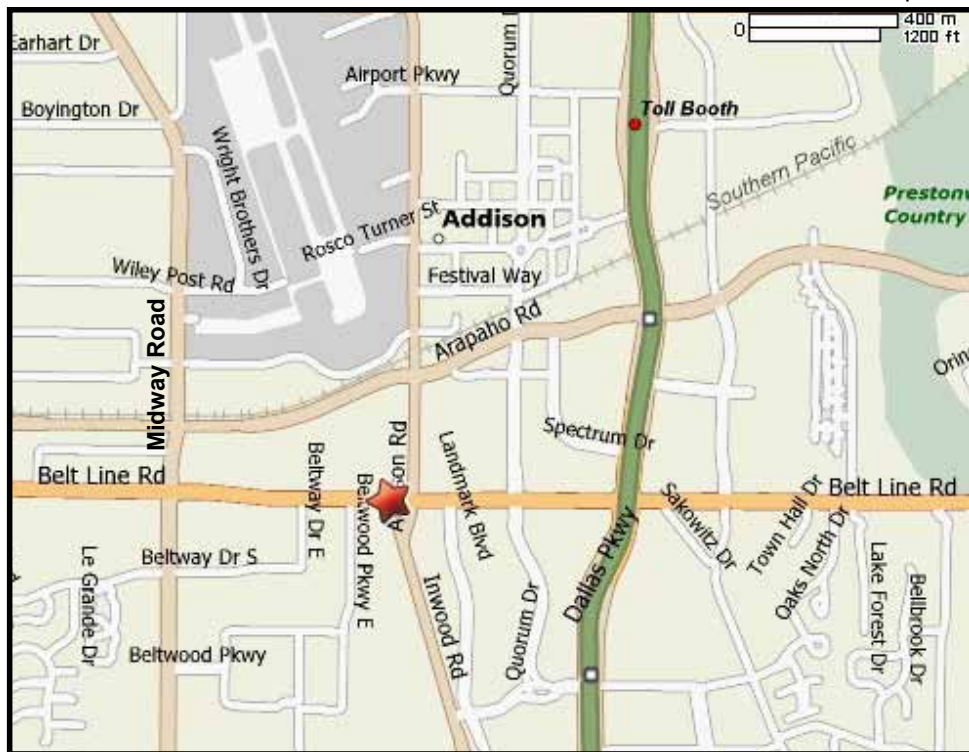

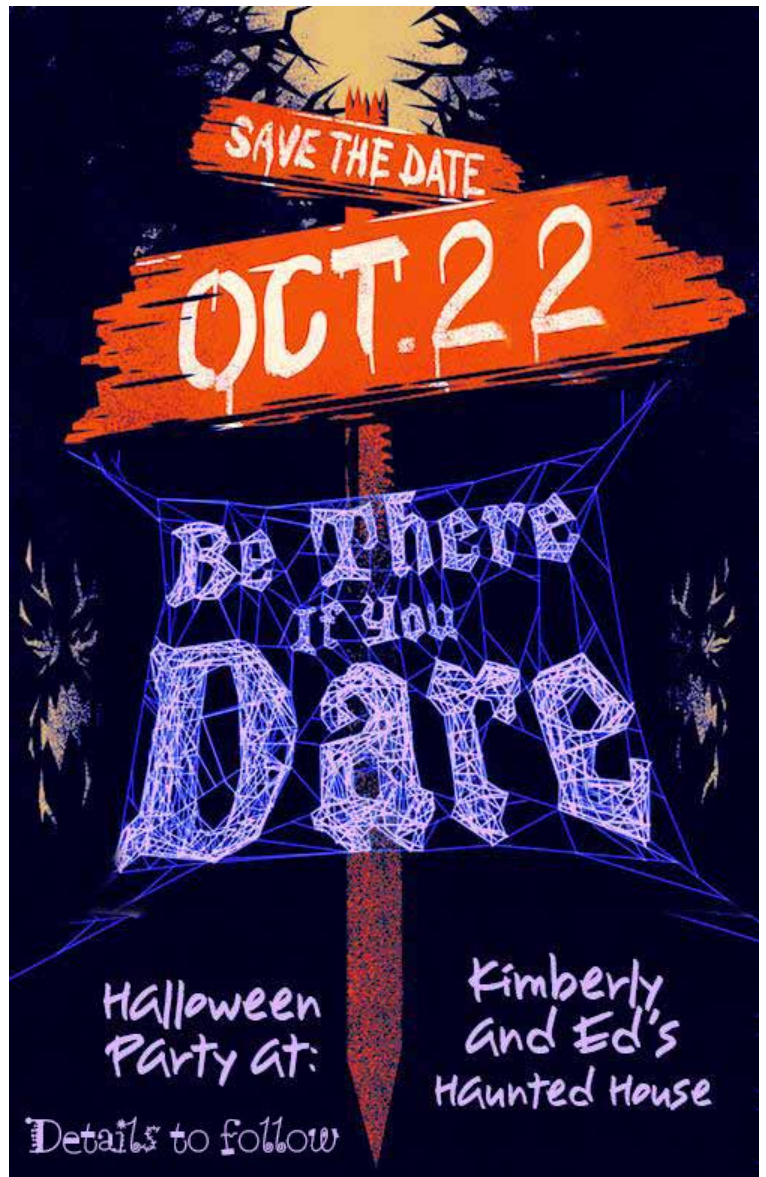

American Windmill Museum

When looking at things to visit prior to the Legends' Palo Duro trip in July, I found a website for the American Windmill Museum in Lubbock. It looked interesting but (always a but...) it's closed on Sunday when Lubbock was on our itinerary. So Craig and I decided to do a 'pre-view' day for the trip and left Thursday morning instead of Friday.

There were plenty of windmills outside and even more inside the huge air conditioned buildings. Windmills were from all over the world with facts about its age, where it was from and how it was used.

But it wasn't just windmills. There was a large collection of hand made, completely furnished doll houses.

A number of model trains were set up and running through the building; complete scenes of old town Lubbock and rural farm areas showing how windmills were used in the past. They even included a Corvette on a flatbed train car



and more in a town scene. The wonderful exhibit of trains is due to the Lubbock Model Railroad Association who runs the displays and has their meetings at the museum.

Another room was filled with various grindstones used by the windmills in the processing of various grains and other items.

It took us a couple hours to see everything inside and it was a fast look outside due to the heat, but it was worth the stop.

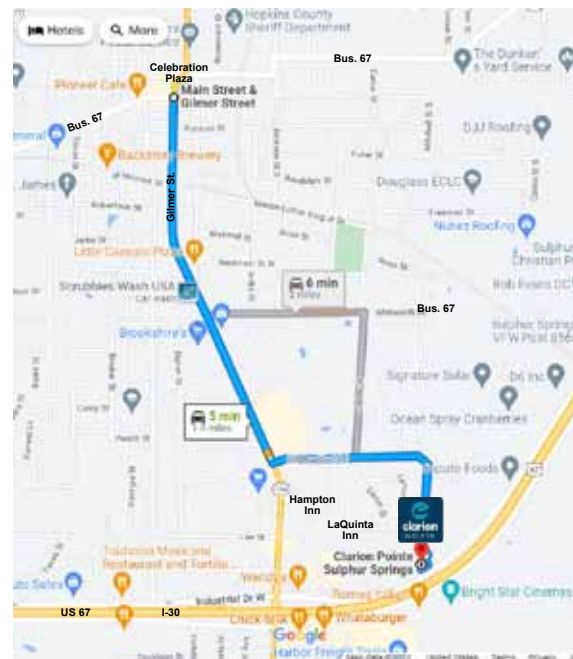
