



Guidelines and Agreement

The legends weekend wrench is a source of help for members who help each other by providing both knowledge and the skills needed to help in restoration and repair of other members Corvettes.

As such, members requesting help with a weekend wrench event should also be helping at other weekend wrench events.

The purpose is not free labor but sharing help, knowledge, ideas, and resources among our club members while enjoying each other's company and a learning experience for all.

The requesting member needs to be aware that more modern Corvettes require computer access and programs that Corvette Legends of Texas does not own or have access to. Therefore, some of those requests sadly may be denied.

The host accepts the responsibility of all liability on the car and property and holds Corvette Legends of Texas not responsible in any area.

The host shall have an adequate garage space and provide all tools to prevent lost tools.

The host shall have the project ready for commencement of work with parts readily available and organized.

Not lurking away on hidden shelves or inside unmarked boxes as in storage.

The host shall have any available assembly manuals, electrical wiring diagrams, and other aids available to assist the members to do the job correctly.

The host shall provide a breakfast of some form for those attending. This doesn't need to be a full blown breakfast, but can range upward from coffee, water, and donuts.

The host is not required, but it is suggested that if the weekend wrench extends past the hour of 1:00 PM provide a small lunch. Suggestion, a local What-A-Burger, etc.

All gasoline cans and tanks shall be sealed and not close to the work area.

Inclement weather will lead to cancellation of any weekend wrench events.

A member, who has previously helped on a weekend wrench event, may apply for a weekend wrench by completing this form and delivering to the weekend wrench coordinator for review.


The project needs to be reviewed for our ability to actually be in a position to help and to check conflicts with dates and prior scheduled events. An answer will be provided within a week after review and approval.

Instructions for 2019 Classic Corral

All cars must use Gate 8 located on Fitzhugh Avenue See attached map for gate location

INBOUND

- ★ Enter Gate 8 and line up along curb on First Ave. (Dos Equis Pavilion side)
- ★ All vehicles need to be staged by 8:30AM at Pennsylvania and First Ave
- * A police motorcycle or golf cart will escort you to the Car Corral A
- * Corvette Legends sets up in Corral space A
- * Since we are in Corral A please leave a lane for Corral B until everyone is in. There can be NO vehicles outside the split rail perimeter during the show

- ★ Tow Vehicles will be led out to the Dos Equis parking lot
- * If a vehicle is late (after 9AM) it will not be allowed into the Corral.
- ★ Ice chests will be allowed but no glass containers and no alcohol shall be brought in.

OUTBOUND

- ★ Vehicles shall be ready to go at 5:30 PM
- ★ A police motorcycle will escort all the vehicles out at 5:45 PM
- ★ All vehicles MUST be gone from the Corral by 6PM. The parade stages at about 6:15PM on First Avenue, if you are late you won't be able to exit
- * Only show vehicles will be allowed in the corral. Any vehicle not in the display group will not be allowed in the gates without purchased parking.
