





Prior to the official start of the meeting, Duffy Oyster, owner of Hula Hut, gave an interesting insight into his appreciation for Corvettes. Starting with a description of the initial Corvette prototype introduced in 1953, when only 300 were produced and sold only to VIP's. He then traced the history to the specially-designed 50th Anniversary Corvette. When GM rejected the design and stayed with a traditional style for anniversary models, former GM designer Steve Pasteiner bought the rights and factory molds, created Advanced Automotive Technologies and produced a limited number of the 50th Commemorative Edition. This retro styling blended the classic styling of the 1953 with the performance, comfort and technology of the 2003. After the first five were produced on a C5 chassis provided by GM, the customers provided the C5 Corvette to build on. Duffy owns one, and his prize Corvette was parked outside for everyone to view.

The meeting was called to order by President Sam Denault at 12:45 pm. Attendance was 49.

All cars must use Gate 8 located on Fitzhugh Avenue **Inbound**

- ☐ Enter Gate 8 and line up along curb on First Ave.
- ☐ All vehicles must be staged by 8am at Pennsylvania and First Ave to enter at 8:30am
- ☐ Police motorcycle or golf cart will escort you to the Corral
- □ NO vehicles outside the split rail fence during the show
- ☐ Tow Vehicles will be led out to the Dos Equis parking lot
- ☐ Absolutely NO political signs or flags.

If a vehicle is late (after 8:30am) it will not be allowed into the Corral. Ice chests will be allowed but no glass and no alcohol shall be brought in.


Outbound

- □ Vehicles shall be ready to go at 5:30 PM
- ☐ A police motorcycle will escort all cars out at 5:45 PM
- ☐ All vehicles must be gone from the Corral by 6 PM. The parade stages at about 6:15 on First Avenue, if you are late you won't be able to exit.


