





Two Tornados Hit Bowling Green









The National Corvette Museum was closed Saturday, December 11 and Sunday, December 12. Since the NCM Motorsports Park was heavily damaged in the storm, events like Touring Laps/Experiences, Twinkle at the Track, and Run, Run Rudolph 5k have officially been canceled until further notice. Significant damage to NCM Motorsports Park, the road course adjacent to the assembly plant. A storage facility for newly built C8s awaiting Museum Delivery, had its roof entirely ripped off.

The National Corvette Museum luckily did not suffer such extensive damage as the assembly plant and motorsports park. Corvette Museum's R8C delivery program has emailed those customers whose new Corvettes were damaged while being stored at the NCM Motorsports Park. The email states that repairs will be attempted prior to your scheduled delivery appointment, however, it's uncertain at this time.

The C8 Corvette production has been plagued by many problems, union negotiations, Covid-19 shut downs, parts shortages and now a tornado!

At the General Motors Bowling Green Assembly Plant, damage to the roof and to an employee entrance led to the plant being shut down at least through the end of the week. Because the storm came through about 1:30 a.m. Saturday, it hit at a time when few employees were at the plant. About 20 to 30 people were inside at the time and took shelter in the basement when emergency alarms sounded. No one was injured.

The small number of employees that were onsite are all safe. The plant, which has about 1,200 hourly employees working two shifts, shut down both shifts through the end of the week. Trained teams are "working to get tooling, equipment and the facility space up to standard." No value on the damage has yet been established, and no decision has been made on returning to production.

Compared to another automotive-related plant, the Corvette plant got off easy. A 108,000-square-foot Stryker Logistics building, where workers cleaned parts for Bowling Green Metalforming and other clients and also provided warehousing and distribution services, was demolished by the tornado and its 150-mph winds. The plant was a pile of rubble Monday. As with the Corvette plant, the timing of the storm meant that none of the 30 employees in the Stryker plant were injured.

Seventeen people were killed in Bowling Green.
