

The Southwest Swap meet will be November 3-4 in Arlington, Lot F at Ranger stadium.




Our parkiung lot full of Vettes attracted this striking Yellow C8 owner to stop.


The musical was presented October

Tom Schipper's 2020 Red Coupe Wins Award at Good-Guys



GoodGuys only allows post-1998 vehicles to be displayed on Sunday of the 3-day show. I took my Torch Red 2020 C-8 Corvette to the show and proudly parked in the Corvette Legends display area. While I was away from the display area admiring all the great cars and trucks. Sam Deneault called and told me I had to move my car to the 'Winner's Circle'. I thought Sam and a few of the others were playing a prank on me, but realized when I returned to our Club area that they were

not. I had a notice on the windshield that my car had earned an 'All-American Sunday Award.'

According to GoodGuys media, the award is given to post-1998 American-made and American-powered cars and trucks. I could find no other criteria, except that this award is left to the judges' picks. Most awards are not determined by a strict point system or a committee of judges. Many awards are chosen because the car or truck grabs their attention, and is a very subjective process - that's why they are called picks. I was unable to



talk to anyone that actually judged my car, so I can't give insight as to what made my car stand out - Sorry!

All I did to my car after parking it in the Club display was wipe it down (mostly to get the brake carbon dust off). I used a detailing spray wax on the paint and wheels, and sprayed the tires with tire-black. I opened both trunks and left the windows down. I did not remove the one-piece hardtop or have any signage or literature about the vehicle. I love my car, am very proud to be a member of Corvette Legends, and honored to receive the award. There are many who have put a lot more effort into their cars and deserve this award more than I do.

Don't Break That Window!

There's a manual door release!

A Florida man was at a gas station in his C7 Corvette convertible and got stuck in his car when the electric door release didn't work. Instead of using the manual door release, he used his cell phone to call the police to get help freeing himself from inside the car. He obviously didn't know about the manual door release located on the floor next to both the driver and passenger doors.

Eventually, Florida firefighters showed up, and before taking extreme measures, they tried to jump the car but broke the passenger window to free the man.

A TikTok video shows the moment a man from Davenport, Florida, had firefighters shatter the passenger window and free the man from the car rather than pull on the manual door release.

Sadly, people don't know that there is a manual override to open the door if the battery dies or there is another electrical issue. This door release is between the seat and the door on the passenger and driver's sides of all Corvettes with electronic doors.



When the passenger door is opened first, the driver door will also unlock. To program this feature, see Vehicle Personalization \diamondsuit 134.

To open a door from the inside, press the door latch button (3).

Loss of Vehicle Electrical Power

If the vehicle has lost battery power, open the doors manually.


